I am a 25 year old male, and I have just completed my bachelor's degree in agriculture.

For the upcoming harvest season, I'm looking for a job as a harvest hand anywhere in New Zealand. I do have experience in crop harvest as I have worked on different farms during the last 5 years. All these farms were located in Germany, growing crops such as wheat, barley, canola and potatoes. Farm sizes varied from 250ha to 1200ha. I was part of a team each season with 3 to 15 people. I can work by myself as well as in a team, but I prefer to work in a large team. I am reliable and honest. If I don't know how to operate a machine, I will ask for instructions and I'm always happy to learn.

Now, I am keen to learn more about farming in New Zealand, your farming systems, and the structure of the primary industry as well as experiencing the New Zealand lifestyle. I am happy to do any tasks given to me. I have worked day as well as night shifts. I am hoping to be part of the farming community and expect to be able to travel in between if the weather and working schedule allow.

• My machinery-, mechanical- and English skills.

I am familiar with driving tractors of the following brands: Fendt, MF and John Deere, including several types of machinery for grass harvest and silage, manure spreading, bailing and the chaser bin. I am familiar with working with the cultivator, disc harrow, and I have made first experiences with the drill and the GPS system such as RTK as well as some driving of a header (Case 7130 and Claas Lexion 780). Most of my time working on farms, I spend driving the chaser bin as well as doing soil work (Ploughing, grubber).

I have made little experience in piggery but have done a few months in the dairy industry. I was helping to milk cows in a 10 side-by-side milking shed. I enjoy the work with livestock, and it would be great to be involved in some animal-related tasks. However, the focus of my future work would be cropping, preferably.

When it comes to working in the workshop and fixing machinery, I can help in a lot of areas but often lack the years of experience to do it myself. I can welt and metal grind but have trouble when it comes to fixing particular parts within the machine.

I learned English in school, starting in year 5 for 7 years. I have then travelled to England for three months. That is now two years ago. At the moment, I would have trouble to understand someone over the phone, it is easier if I talk face to face, but I am keen to improve my language skills quickly.

• My expectations, work attitude and additional information

I am always happy to learn and keen to drive old machinery, not necessarily the biggest and newest tractors. I am an open-minded person who has done a bit of travelling and knows about the differences in mentality of each nationality. I enjoy getting to know the local people and their sense of humour. I expect to be given some responsibility and to work on my own and in a team, depending on the task. Important to me are a nice team, the chance of getting away for day trips on days without work and preferably shared accommodation. I hold a driver licence for car and tractor. My work visa has been granted,

and as soon as I know where I'll be working, I will book my flights. I am keen to get to know farming in your country and would like to be able to ask questions about the differences to our farming system and the challenges you face.
